Key Issues

- Reduced tow size from St. Louis to Cairo, daylight only through Thebes bridge (UM 50)
- Poor operating conditions on the Illinois River, high water/flows now main concern
- No fog last night, wind delays on the Canals until tomorrow, fog again early next week
- Poor operating conditions on the Ohio River above Racine Lock (OR 237) due to high water

Ohio/Tennessee/Cumberland

High water Ohio River...daylight restrictions - Daylight only operations at the following locks, Racine (OR 237), Markland (OR 531), and McAlpine (OR 607). We also have daylight only transit through Cincinnati (OR 473), as the river as risen above 45'. Current forecast have the river falling below 45' at the end of next week.

High water on the Ohio River, expect slower transits and longer await pickup times.

Ice on the Upper Ohio - Ice is no longer causing major issues, most of the ice that is left is flowing down the river, expect minor delays.

Cumberland River closed at Cheatham Lock (CR 149) for high water - Expected to last until Monday

Chicago/Illinois/Upper Miss

Ice on the Illinois River - Ice is no longer causing major issues, most of the ice that is left is flowing down the river, expect minor delays.

<u>High water/flows on the Illinois River</u> - High flows are preventing tows from transiting through Starved Rock Lock (IR 231) and Marseilles Lock (IR 245). Some boats may experience bridge clearance issues, especially in the Ottawa (IR 236) area due to the high water. Expect this to last another 2-3 days.

The Upper Miss closed for dredging - Dredging is ongoing and expected to conclude on Saturday, February 9. The river will be closed nightly from 17:00 until 07:00 the following day. The closures will occur 7 days a week.

<u>Ice causing delays at Mel Price Lock (UM 201)</u> - Ice continues to build above the lock, making transit difficult in this area, expect delays. Boats are transiting through the lock, but operations are moving slowly.

Reduced tow size from St. Louis to Cairo - Tows reduced by one string (5 barges)

Daylight only transit through Thebes bridge (UM 50)

Lower Miss/Gulf/Canals

Reduced tow sizes Cairo to Gulf - High water has reduced tow sizes between Cairo and the Gulf by one-two strings, 5-10 barges, expect increased await pickup delays on SB barges.

Daylight only through Memphis (LM 725) - Daylight only on a boat by boat basis.

Daylight only through Vicksburg bridge (LM 435) - Due to high water, tows can only transit through Vicksburg bridge during daylight hours.

<u>Daylight only through Baton Rouge (LM 237)</u> - Due to high water, tows can only transit through Baton Rouge bridge during daylight hours.

Fog/Wind delays - No fog last night. The canals will experience wind delays until Saturday PM. There will be a brief 24-48 window of improved conditions, but then fog is expected to roll back in early next week. Expect significant delays in pickup and transit times.

Delay at Industrial Lock (LM 93) - Current queue is 52 boats.

Shuttle boats in the Gulf are reduced to 9-12 barges due to high water and high flows.

Max draft coming into or out of the Gulf in the SouthWest Pass (LM 3) - Blue water vessels are restricted to 40' in this area, dredging is ongoing, 96 vessels in queue to come in/out of the Gulf.

High water in the Morgan City area (WC 99) - Expect slow traffic through this area until water levels fall.

Brazos Lock (WC 401) is closed daily for repairs - Lock will be closed during weekdays from 07:00-17:00. Repairs will not take place during periods of high flows.

<u>Calcasieu Lock (WC 238) Closure</u>—Beginning on July 30, the lock will only be closed Monday-Thursday from 07:00-17:00. This change is an effort to help control the major delays occurring at this lock. Contractors will demolish the south chamber guide wall and start construction of a new guide wall. **The lock will be closed Monday-Thursday from 07:00—17:00 each day. Current queue is 23 boats.**

High water on the Warrior Tombigbee River - Reduced tow sizes and slow transits between Mobile (WT 2) and areas North.

Special Note - Please be aware, ACBL's standard contract, under the "River Closures and Restricted Movements" section, gives ACBL the right to bill for lock delays.

Inland Waterway Weather Report

One Event Down...Next to Begin on Sunday highlighting the weather today.

- High pressure will dominate the weather over the watershed today/tomorrow with colder temperatures and relatively dry conditions expected over the entire watershed.
- A cold front will move out of the Plains States and across the watershed Sunday-Tuesday. Another round of moderate to locally heavy rain/freezing rain/snow is forecasted for the region north of Cairo...and moderate to heavy rain is expected over the region south of Cairo. It appears that the colder air will push a little farther south than Wednesday/Yesterday's event which, if it occurs, would keep the heavier rains south of the mainstem Ohio.
- Model guidance suggests that another moderate to heavy rain/snow event will occur beginning next Friday. Model guidance still shows the heaviest rains will fall over AR/TN/KY. Guidance also suggests the possibility that these heavy rain events could end by the last week of February.

7day QPF totals (through Friday morning):

- ½-2" of rain/freezing rain/snow are forecasted for the region north of Cairo.
- 1-5" of rain are forecasted for the region south of Cairo.
